

UNIVERSITY SEMINARS

Over the past eleven years Winning edge strategies has provided regular yearly seminars to a large number of university colleges throughout NSW on the topic of **sexual harassment and date rape awareness**.

Each seminar has been specifically designed to deal effectively with all aspects of sexual harassment and date rape from the perspective of the group being presented to. Topics covered include:

- What is sexual harassment? An in-depth look at what constitutes sexual harassment together with an over-view of university sexual harassment policy.
- Specific examples of typical cases of sexual harassment within the university community and how such situations can be avoided.
- A discussion of the likely consequences following a formal complaint of sexual harassment outlining how a substantiated complaint can lead to severe ramifications.
- When does sexual harassment become a criminal offence? Defining when unwanted sexual contact becomes a sexual offence such as indecent assault and/or sexual assault.
- A full explanation of relevant legal terms relating to sexual crime together with an outline of the complaint process.
- Real-life examples of indecent/sexual assault.
- Understanding the offender's 'mind-set of justification' present in most date rape situations and how to exploit this mind-set, (women's course only).
- The most effective strategy to adopt in a date rape confrontation, (women's course only)
- Both male and female seminars allow sufficient time for open discussion and Q & A.
